Some consider it to be the "backbone" of ETAdirect. It shows a hierarchical view of the organization's resources, such as technicians, trucks, tools, and equipment. Resources are organized into what are referred to in ETAdirect as groups and buckets. To view the resources or sub-groups or buckets within one, you must expand the bucket or group by clicking the plus sign to the left of it. For example, click the plus sign to expand the Florida-USA group.	[Information caption] The Resource Tree shows a hierarchical view of resources, such as technicians, trucks, tools, and equipment. Groups are typically used to provide a segmentation of an organization in a way that makes it easier for ETAdirect users to find and manage activities and resources. Common examples of groups include, but are not limited to geographic (ie. North, South) or organizational (i.e. department or supervisor's name) differentiations. Buckets Buckets provide a couple different operational functions (in addition to segmentation similar to groups) in that they support both routing and quota/capacity management. For routing purposes, buckets serve as repositories for activities from which routing will distribute them among "child" resources. Resources Resources typically represent records of the field workforce (technicians, trucks, tools, etc.) who perform the activities and the items that are paired with those people. Resources are often the owners of activities, which are assigned to them based on skills, geographical locations, and their availability to perform them within the associated time windows. 

To enable the lower pane, click the plus sign, and the current selection appears again in the lower pane by default. Notice though, that there is another instance of the Resource Tree available. From here, you can make your tree selection and choose the view of the activities in the lower pane. This provides an efficient way to compare two different routes or lists, move activities easily between the selections, or view scheduled and non-scheduled activities simultaneously. 
