



Some consider it to be the “backbone” of ETAdirect. It shows a hierarchical view of the organization’s resources, such as technicians, trucks, tools, and equipment.</p> <p data-bbox="724 428 1276 521">Resources are organized into what are referred to in ETAdirect as groups and buckets. Click on each type to learn more about it.</p> <p>Once you're done exploring, click Continue.</p>	<p><b>Groups, Buckets &amp; Resources</b></p> <p><b>Groups</b> Use groups to sort and organize the other items in the Resource Tree. Groups are typically used to provide a segmentation of an organization in a way that makes it easier for ETAdirect users to find and manage activities and resources. Common examples of groups include, but are not limited to geographic (ie. North, South) or organizational (i.e. department or supervisor's name) differentiations.</p> <p><b>Buckets</b> Buckets provide a couple different operational functions (in addition to segmentation similar to groups) in that they support both routing and quota/capacity management. For routing purposes, buckets serve as repositories for activities from which routing will distribute them among "child" resources.</p> <p><b>Resources</b> Resources typically represent records of the field workforce (technicians, trucks, tools, etc.) who perform the activities and the items that are paired with those people. Resources are often the owners of activities, which are assigned to them based on skills, geographical locations, and their availability to perform them within the associated time windows.</p>	<p>Three types represented by icons and abstract image behind.</p> <p>Content area with text that changes dynamically.</p>





